January 6th - Psalm 2 - The Enthronement of the King
January 20th - Psalm 20 & 21 - The Experiences of the King
February 10th - Psalm 45 - The Expectation of the King
February 17th - Psalm 72 - The Endowment of the King
March 2nd - Psalm 89 - The Exaltation of the King
March 16th - Psalm 110 - The Establishment of the King

(A Royal Psalm is one that brings before us, Christ the King/Anointed or David as King. Many would consider the following Psalms to be Royal, 2,18,20,21,45,72,89,101,110,132 & 144. Psalm 89 will bring Book 3 of the Psalms to a close, keep in mind the 5 book division of the Psalms. Book #1 1-41, #2 42-72, #3 73-89, #4 90-106 & #5 107-150)

Psalms 89, according to the title, is a ‘Maschil’ or a teaching/instructive poem. There are 13 of these in the Psalms (32,42,44,45,52,53,54,55,74,78,88,**89** & 142). Psalm 89 is unique in that it is the only one to use four ‘selah’, we will have to find out why. As well, we will notice the word ‘LORD’ (#3068) ten times!

Psalm 89 will be looked at in three sections under the following headings:

THE GREAT PROBLEM verses 38-51 *(We will touch this section first, 5-10 mins)*

THE GREATER PRAYER verse 52 *(We will end with this section)*

THE GREATEST PROSPECT verses 1-37 *(We will spend the bulk of our time here, considering the following points...)*

The Covenant with David
The Creation we see
The Character of God
